Materials List

Please bring:

Sketchbook, photos, or images to work from

Paper Towels

Cotton rags

Old paint brushes, chopsticks

Q-tips

Newsprint Pad, 14" x 17" or larger

Scissors, X-acto Knife

Soft brayers, varying sizes

Tweezers

China markers (black and red or another color)

Ink spatula or putty knife

Window scraper (razor)

a few pieces of 4 ply mat board "windows" (leftovers) or straight mat board 8" x 10" or smaller.

Available to purchase at WSA:

1 piece tarlatan

2 blotters

a few sheets of good printmaking paper (Rives, BFK, etc.)

Optional Materials that you'll probably wish you brought:

a small piece of screening material, sandpaper (varying grades), a piece of corrugated cardboard, colored tissue paper or Japanese paper, latex gloves.

Please note:

Ink, solvent, and plexiglass plates will be provided. If you want to work larger than 8" x 10", please bring your own plate, and make sure it is .050" thick.

ABSOLUTELY NO MINERAL SPIRITS OR TURPENTINE ARE TO BE USED ON PREMISES!!!
ONLY LOW TOXICITY SOLVENTS SUCH AS *TURPENOID NATURAL* ARE ALLOWED.
