Small sketchbook (8" x 10" or smaller)  
4b pencil  
pencil sharpener  
eraser  
black felt tip pen (Sharpies are good)

If you don't use an easel:  
bring a lightweight rigid board to work on (and clips or push pins)  
and a stool or cushion to sit on

*Also . . .*  
a visor or hat  
bug spray and sun block  
lunch and lots of drinking water  
bathing suit and towel (you never know)

I will give out direction to the next day's class each afternoon. Bring some pictures or images to work from in case it rains (I'M SURE IT WON'T).
