PAINT: The following three palettes are used by Zhang and Woolley. The colors listed for every one of the three palettes are required, except where otherwise noted.

Required for all palettes: Titanium White, Ivory Black

Colors of Blue/Orange Palette:

BG	(Blue-Green, or Turquoise)	RO	(Red-Orange)
B	(Blue)	O	(Orange)
BV	(Blue-Violet)	YO	(Yellow-Orange)

Optional, but recommended:

List of paints you need, if you buy student grade paints:

Here is one way to fulfill the color list. Students need to use a lot of paint in order to learn how to use paint. Student grade paints are less expensive. They contain less pigment by volume than artist grade. There are several brands of student grade paints available. Here is a list of the required colors if you use Daler Rowney Georgian brand:

- BG Daler Rowney Georgian Prussian Green
- B Daler Rowney Georgian Cobalt Blue Hue
- BV Old Holland Blue Violet (note: there is no Daler Rowney equivalent)
- RO Daler Rowney Georgian Cadmium Red Light Hue
- O Daler Rowney Georgian Chrome Orange Deep Hue
- YO Daler Rowney Georgian Chrome Orange Hue
- V Daler Rowney Georgian Cobalt Violet Hue
- RV Daler Rowney Georgian Permanent Magenta
- Y Daler Rowney Georgian Cadmium Yellow Hue
- YG Daler Rowney Georgian Yellow Green
- G Daler Rowney Georgian Permanent Light Green
- R Daler Rowney Georgian Cadmium Red Deep Hue
- RU Daler Rowney Georgian Raw Umber
- Daler Rowney Georgian Titanium White
- Daler Rowney Georgian Ivory Black

List of paints you need, if you buy artist grade paints (not necessary for this class):

Here is one way to fulfill the color list using artist grade paints (more expensive). There are many brands of artist grade oil paint which may provide the following colors. The following list relies on the Old Holland brand, except for the blue-green.

- BG Maimeri Puro Green Blue (409)
- B Old Holland Cobalt Blue
- BV Old Holland Blue-Violet
- RO Old Holland Cadmium Red Light
- O Old Holland Cadmium orange
- YO Old Holland Cadmium Yellow Extra Deep
- V Old Holland Bright Violet
- RV Old Holland Magenta
- Y Old Holland Cadmium Yellow light
- YG Old Holland Cinnabar Green Light Extra
- G Old Holland Bright Green
- R Old Holland Cadmium Red Deep
- RU Old Holland Raw Umber
- Old Holland Titanium White
- Old Holland Ivory Black

Medium: "Couch", a medium made using refined linseed oil and Canada Balsam. Available in class for \$10 per 2 oz. bottle. Students will learn that not much medium is needed per painting session. One 2 oz. bottle will probably last for eight weeks of class.

Brushes: Hog bristle filberts, at least two brushes from each size range (two large, two medium, two small)

Large hog bristle filberts: Sizes 8 - 12

Medium hog bristle filberts: Sizes 4 - 7

Small hog bristle filberts: Sizes 1 - 3

Paper towels: A roll of Scott Brand, Original style "Shop" paper towels (they are blue colored) from a hardware store, Home depot, or Napa auto parts store. The "Shop" paper towels do not shred and disintegrate as easily as other types. If you cannot find the Original style, then the regular style (waffle weave) blue Scott "Shop" paper towels are also good.

Alternately, you can use "Viva" brand paper towels from the super market. These are not as durable as the "Shop" towels, but are better than any other supermarket brand.

Canvas: Sizes of stretched canvas as requested in class by the teacher.

Palette: We prefer a glass palette. If you keep the glass palette in a Masterson palette box, the paint will last longer. The Masterson palette box holds a 12" x 16" palette and is available locally at Catskill Art Supply, and at other fine arts supply stores.

You can have a glass mad for you at any glass store: Ask for a piece of ¼ inch plate glass measuring 12 x 16 inches, with a one inch diagonal cut at one corner (for ease of lifting the glass out of the palette box), and ask for polished edges. This should cost less than \$15.

Place a sheet of neutral color paper in the bottom of the Masteson palette box then place the glass on top.

Other supplies: Sketchbook, vine charcoal, charcoal pencils, palette knife for scraping canvas.

Optional but recommended: A digital camera, and a viewfinder (for instructions on how to make your own viewfinder from two scraps of mat board, see the class monitor).
