A small piece of nylon screening material, sandpaper (varying grades), a piece of corrugated cardboard, colored tissue paper, Japanese paper, a few sheets of good printmaking paper (Rives, BFK etc. some paper is available at the school), latex gloves, hand cream

Ink, solvent and plexiglass plates will be provided. If you want to work larger than 8 x 10, please bring your own plate, and make sure it is .050" thick.
