- 1 Scissors
- 1 Razor Blade
- 10 Toothpicks
- 1 Small Can of Drafting Powder
- 8 Pairs of Latex Gloves
- 2 Fan Brushes (2 Different Sizes)
- Pastels (Range of Colors)
- Total of 100 ML of Ink (1 Brown & 1 Other Color)
- 1 Ballpoint Pen
- 1 Gluestick
- 24 Pieces of Assorted Pastel Paper (Heavyweight, Smooth, Rough, Colors, (9”x12”)
- 1 Small Sponge
- 6 Pieces of Heavyweight Wet Media Paper (Any Color 9”x12”)
- 1 Piece of Mylar 24”x36”
